Detailed Report:

AVIARA 1.0 commenced at 9:30 AM in the Mechanical Seminar Hall with an inaugural ceremony attended by faculty members, invited dignitaries, and enthusiastic UG participants. The event began with the lighting of the lamp, symbolizing knowledge and new beginnings, followed by a warm welcome address by the Head of the Department of Aviation Management.

Mr. Abrar Hussain, IQAC Coordinator of AIGS, addressed the gathering and emphasized the importance of quality initiatives in academic institutions. He spoke about how co-curricular and inter-department events contribute significantly to holistic student development. He encouraged students to actively participate in such platforms to enhance their confidence, leadership abilities, and collaborative skills.

2. **The Final Boarding Box** – A time-bound activity that assessed quick thinking and coordination.
3. **The Black Box Mystery** – A crisis management round involving analytical reasoning and case evaluation.
4. **Code Red: Terminal X** – A high-pressure decision-making and problem-solving simulation.
5. **Startup Auction Arena** – An entrepreneurial round where teams pitched innovative aviation startup ideas and strategically bid for resources.

Between rounds, cultural performances by students added vibrancy and entertainment to the program. The aviation-themed decor, announcements, and event coordination created an immersive airport-like experience for participants and the audience.

Faculty members and invited judges evaluated participants based on creativity, teamwork, clarity of presentation, innovation, and time management. The competitive spirit, enthusiasm, and active involvement from all departments made the event highly engaging.

The program concluded with a grand prize distribution ceremony. Winners were awarded certificates and trophies, and all participants were appreciated for their commendable performance and sportsmanship.


