
Mission


Visit to Karnataka Silk Industry Cooperation

Visit to handicrafts service center








Visit to TUMUL Diary, Tumkur



Visit to Intertek India Pvt Ltd



Assuming all components of fabric, design, and trims are acceptable and correctly planned and cut, the next stage is to extend the cutting room programme to the sewing room. Sewing Garments are sewn in an assembly line, with the garment becoming complete as it progresses down the sewing line. Sewing machine operators receive a bundle of cut fabric and repeatedly sew the same portion of the garment, passing that completed portion to the next operator.



Visit to Vikasat Janahit Trust

Navigation and Emergency Procedures:


Instruction on basic navigation techniques and the use of navigation equipment. Simulated emergency procedures were carried out, providing students with essential skills to handle in-flight emergencies.



Visit to Domestic Immersion program



Training at the academy is rigorous, starting as early as 5 AM and lasting for 11 months. Those who fail to meet the standards have an additional two years to pass, failing which they are dismissed from the program.

Guest Talk On Mental Retardation





Celebration Of Kargil Vijay Diwas Celebration NCC

After the Indo-Pakistani War of 1971, there had been a long period of relatively few direct armed conflicts involving the military forces of the two neighbors – notwithstanding the efforts of both nations to control the Siachen Glacier by establishing military outposts on the surrounding mountains ridges and the resulting military skirmishes in the 1980s. During the 1990s, however, escalating tension and conflict due to separatist activities in Kashmir, as well as the conducting of nuclear tests by both countries in 1998, led to an increasingly belligerent atmosphere. In this situation, both countries signed the Lahore Declaration in February 1999, promising to provide a peaceful and bilateral solution to the Kashmir conflict. During the winter of 1998–1999, some elements of the Pakistani Armed Forces were covertly training and sending Pakistani troops and paramilitary forces, into territory on the Indian side of the line of control (LOC). The infiltration was code-named "Operation Badri". The aim of the Pakistani incursion was to sever the link between Kashmir and Ladakh and cause Indian forces to withdraw from the Siachen Glacier, thus forcing India to negotiate a settlement of the broader Kashmir dispute.




AECC Training Program


participants to analyse and devise strategic solutions to complex business problems. The primary purpose of these competitions is to bridge the gap between academic learning and practical application.



Internship Orientation








Online Certificate Course

Panel Discussion on Interim Union Budget




students. She started on a very good note and the energy continued till the end. She also emphasized on the importance of health and how it affects the life span of an individual.



Orientation on Specialisation





Webinar on Investors Awareness Program




of NSDL. On October 14, 2023, the Department of Management had a “An Investor awareness program” for final year students. A total of 85 students attended this outstanding session.

Quantitative Research Methods





Student Lit Gen Fest





Gender Sensitization






Women Health Menstrual Hygiene

International Yoga Day




